# AUDIT & ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE MEETING HELD IN ROOM #318 PUTNAM COUNTY OFFICE BUILDING CARMEL, NEW YORK 10512

Members: Chairman Castellano and Legislators Ellner & Gouldman

Thursday February 22, 2024 (Immediately following Personnel & Health Mtgs. beginning at 6:30pm)

The meeting was called to order at 6:53pm by Chairman Castellano who requested Legislator Gouldman lead in the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon roll call Legislator Gouldman and Chairman Castellano were present. Legislator Ellner was absent.

Item #3 – Acceptance of Minutes – January 29, 2024

The minutes were accepted as submitted.

Item #4 - Correspondence/County Auditor

a. Sales Tax Report

Legislator Gouldman stated it is great to begin the year with an increase in sales tax over the same time period last year.

Item #5 - Correspondence/ Commissioner of Finance

- a. Overtime/Temporary Report Duly Noted
- b. Approval/ Budgetary Amendment 23A093/ Finance/ Year End Entry #3

Commissioner of Finance Michael Lewis stated this is to close out the books for 2023. He explained that surplus funds were used to correct the accounts for last year. He stated there may be one (1) or two (2) more Year End Entries being submitted.

Chairman Castellano made a motion to pre-file the necessary resolution; Seconded by Legislator Gouldman. All in favor.

c. Approval/ Budgetary Amendment 24A010/ Sheriff & Dept. of Social Services/ NYS Dept. of Homeland Security & Emergency Services Domestic Terrorism Prevention Grant Award (Also reviewed in Protective)

Commissioner Lewis stated this is officially accepting the grant award and appropriating the funding into the appropriate accounts broken down between the Department of Social Services (DSS), the Bureau of Emergency Services, and the Sheriff's Department.

Legislator Montgomery stated at the Protective Services Committee Meeting this month she inquired about the insurance for the TAM (Threat Assessment Management) Team and how it varies from the ERT (Emergency Response Team). She stated she is hopeful an answer will be provided.

Legislator Crowley questioned when the County will receive word if this grant can be extended.

Commissioner Lewis stated he would defer to DSS Commissioner Sara Servadio, but he believes it is possible to be extended. He stated if the funds are not able to be spent, he suggested contacting the program manager to ask if they can be repurposed.

Legislator Nacerino stated the ERT was never sanctioned by the Legislature. She stated the TAM team is mandated by the State and is not required to have County approval.

Legislative Counsel Firriolo stated after reviewing the IMA (Inter-Municipal Agreement) that was approved by the Town of Carmel to form the ERT, he found it explicitly required the approval of all municipalities joining the Team. He stated the County never ratified the IMA and it was therefore never valid.

Chairman Castellano made a motion to pre-file the necessary resolution; Seconded by Legislator Gouldman. All in favor.

d. Approval/ Budgetary Amendment 24A016/ Finance/ Change in Funding Source for 4 Rooftop HVAC Units at Putnam County Courthouse (Also reviewed in Physical)

Commissioner Lewis stated part of the capital plan was to try and obtain this funding through State aid, however the State classified this work as a "major" repair and therefore it was not eligible. He stated fortunately, the County has capital reserve funds for projects such as this one.

Legislator Crowley questioned if HVAC is considered a luxury and would therefore be considered a minor repair. She stated air conditioning is not necessary, only heat is. She spoke to the age of the building.

Chairman Castellano clarified these HVAC units are for the new Putnam County Courthouse. He questioned if there is a timeframe when this work needs to be done.

Commissioner Lewis stated he believes the Department of Public Works would like to begin soon to avoid prices increasing and to get the work done before the summer.

Chairman Castellano made a motion to pre-file the necessary resolution; Seconded by Legislator Gouldman. All in favor.

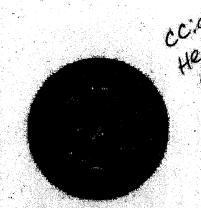

I kindly request the Legislature review and consider a budgetary amendment to transfer \$47,458 of CRSSAA COVID-relief funding (Account 55997000 53000 52103) to the Transit Buses line (Account 55997000 53000 51711). Last year, the County was awarded 5307 funding to purchase several replacement vehicles for PART including 4 Transit vans and a replacement bus. Due to substantial inflation of vehicle pricing, we underestimated the price increases for these. I have attached a budget summary of the award amount with the current purchase prices for your information. The proposed transfer would allow us to utilize awarded COVID-relief funding to complete these vehicle purchases.

Therefore, I kindly request that this item be added to the next Physical Services Subcommittee agenda for consideration. Thank you in advance for your consideration.

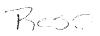

Putnam County Office for Senior Resources requests approval for the purchase of a 2024 Chrysler Pacifica modified with BraunAbility wheelchair accessibility features from Bussani Mobility Team East or an alternate bidder for use by the OSR volunteer medical transportation program.

OSR wishes to replace its 1 remaining wheelchair 2014 Mobility Ventures MV-1 vehicle and replace it with a new Chrysler Pacifica wheelchair accessible modified van. OSR operates two wheel chair accessible vehicles for transportation to senior medical appointments by volunteer senior drivers:

• OSR has sought to replace the MV-1s with more conventional vans as the search for replacement parts for MV-1s is challenging with long lead times and costly prices.

Due to the accessibility customization, purchasing this vehicle (versus lease) would be the best option at an all-inclusive price of approximately \$63,395. We are requesting approval for \$70,000 (in case there is adverse movement in the sales price and equipment availability by the time we are prepared to purchase) from the Jane Lobdell bequeathment fund for this purchase.

It is respectfully requested that this matter be placed on the agenda for the next meeting of the appropriate committees.

### APPROVAL/ LITIGATION SETTLEMENT/ TO AUTO FINANCE LLC V. COUNTY OF PUTNAM

WHEREAS, on or about November 4, 2021, Plaintiff TD Auto Finance LLC (Plaintiff) commenced action against the County of Putnam in United States District Court, Southern District of New York alleging Section 1983 civil rights violations, specifically that the County's practice and custom in civil forfeiture matters did not provide Plaintiff with due process of law as Plaintiff was not timely notified of the seizure of the subject vehicle and not provided with an opportunity to be heard at any point in connection with the seizure; and

WHEREAS, Plaintiff sought recovery for financial damages in an undetermined amount as

well as costs, disbursements, attorney's fees and interest; and

WHEREAS, the County's insurer, NYMIR, assigned the Portale Randazzo law firm, James A. Randazzo, Esq., to defend the County's interests in this matter, which litigation has been handled

by counsel since action was commenced; and

WHEREAS, following extensive motion practice the Court granted Plaintiff's motion for summary judgment determining in doing so that the County violated Plaintiff's procedural due process rights under the Pourteenth Amendment concerning the County's handling of the subject impounded vehicle; and

WHEREAS, Plaintiff proposed for consideration a settlement with the County subject to the County Attorney's endorsement and Legislature's approval, in which the County, would pay Plaintiff, inclusive of attorneys! fees and costs, the sum of one hundred fifteen thousand two

hundred sixty six dollars and forty five cents (\$115,266.45); and

WHEREAS, in response to Plaintiff's settlement demand of \$115,266.45, outside counsel, negotiated a reduced settlement of one hundred two thousand five hundred dollars (\$102,500.00); and

WHEREAS, the County Attorney, the County's outside counsel, James A. Randazzo, Esq., and NYMIR's claims representative conditionally recommended settlement as an alternative to proceeding with an appeal that outside counsel does not believe will be successful; and

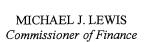
