PUTNAM COUNTY CENTER BASED PROGRAM TRANSPORTATION DISCUSSION

Typically, children under the age of five who attend early childhood programs are transported there by parents, legal guardians, or other authorized individuals (PGA's). This benefits everyone by providing parents with regular, informal contact with the program and staff and keeps PGA's involved in their child's day. New York State Education law encourages PGA's to transport children to center based special education programs. If desired, PGA's can be reimbursed for their mileage with public funding for the portion of the trip that the child is in the car.

If a child would be unable to attend a recommended center based special education program because a PGA is unable to transport such child, the County will arrange for the child to be transported. However, there are limitations to the <u>pick-up</u> (<u>before the program</u>) and <u>drop off</u> (<u>after the program</u>) locations. Specifically, <u>the pick up and drop off locations must</u>:

 $m{B}$ e within Putnam County, be consistent on a weekly basis, and fall along established vehicle routes

PGA's should be aware that the location of their home in relation to the center based special education program, and the total number of children on the vehicle will influence the length of a trip for each child. As numbers of children change throughout the year, the time of the trip may vary accordingly. **It is possible for a child to be on the vehicle for over an hour each way**. It is also possible that a child's route may include a vehicle transfer which means that a child will start a route on one vehicle and then transfer, with supervision, onto another vehicle at a designated transfer location.

When County transportation is determined to be necessary, a separate <u>Transportation Information Form</u> will be completed by the program the child attends with PGA information regarding specific pick up and drop off details. That form will be forwarded to the County for transportation arrangements.
