RE: PIN 8756.09 Fair St. Reconstruction – Culvert Replacements Near DeColores and Winwater

The County's contractor proposes to demolish the two existing culverts (located between DeColores Dr. and Glenna Dr.) and construct new, pre-stressed concrete culverts in the same locations during a 10-day closure of Fair Street. This work is being planned to coincide with Spring Break at Carmel High School to minimize disturbance. The closure will begin during the night of March 27 and end on April 5. The contractor will be working during a day shift and a night shift each day with traffic control personnel and signage stationed to guide motorists. Heavy equipment, including excavators, crane, and dump trucks, will be used at all hours.

This 10-day schedule will expedite the completion of the project and reduce the project cost.

The Contractor, Town of Carmel and Putnam County DPW will have staff monitoring the work at all times. Any unanticipated issues that may arise will be addressed in as timely a manner as possible. The traveling public will be required to use the signed detour route(s). Local traffic will still have access to locations approaching the project zone (depicted on the attached map), but through traffic will not be possible. Accommodation will be provided for residents who live within and around the project zone.

Upcoming work will include improvements to the driveway at Carmel High School, realignment of Vink Drive, completion of sidewalks, streetlights, traffic signals, and turning lane at the Rt. 52 intersection end of the project, and final paving of the entire project area. The project is scheduled for completion in Autumn of this year.
