Forward

Revolutionary War Patriots Buried in Putnam County, New York represents an updated and expanded version of a similar publication compiled by the Enoch Crosby Chapter NSDAR in 2012 commemorating the 200th anniversary of the founding of Putnam County. This current publication was compiled in celebration of the semiquincentennial year of our nation's independence fulfilling the DAR's mission areas of historic preservation, education and patriotism.

Every attempt has been made to identify and locate all Revolutionary War patriots who lived or are buried in Putnam County. Included are men and women who demonstrated unflinching loyalty to the cause of American independence from England from April 19, 1775, through November 26, 1783, through three types of service: Military, Civil and Patriotic. We have **not** attempted to list **all** military service of an individual.

Military Service is found in original records. For a better understanding of the military during the war such as The Line, The Levies, and The Militia, see Roberts, *New York in the Revolution*, 1897.

Civil Service is credited to those individuals who conducted public business under the authority of the new federal, state, county or town governments – **judges, jurors, and supervisors of the highway**, for example.

Patriotic Service includes members of the Provincial Congress, including state governors and legislators, members of the Continental Congress, various committees, Boston Tea Party participants, signers of an Oath of Allegiance or Fidelity, signers of petitions with explicit patriotic language, defenders of forts, doctors who rendered aid to American wounded. Individuals paying the **Oct 1779 Supply Tax** are considered to have supported the Revolution because a portion of the funds was specifically used for the war effort.

Ministers – Those who supported the revolution through preaching to their congregations are considered patriots.

Wives - Since many wives were as supportive of the cause as their husbands, we have included them and noted with a heart ♥ if they are buried near the patriot.

Birth Dates - Rather than listing the birth and death dates, many gravestones of the 18th and 19th centuries list the death date and exact age of the decedent. Therefore, many of the birth dates are not taken directly from the stone but instead are estimated using the death date and age.

This DAR chapter project is really a work in progress and is not meant to be a final definitive statement of service or participation in the Revolutionary War. There are men of the same name, some related, some not, requiring a deep dive into family history to clarify who is connected with which service. We have not attempted in-depth research into family history.

A Few Definitions

(Roberts, 1897, pp vi – vii)

The Line: regiments under George Washington, the United States.

The Levies: “drafts from the different militia regiments, and from the people direct as well, and which could be called upon to serve outside the State during their entire term.”

The Militia: “could only be called out of the State for three months at a time.”

Associated Exempts: “a unique class” and were authorized by an act of April 3, 1778. They comprised “All persons under the age of sixty who have held civil or military commissions and are not or shall not be re-appointed to their respective proper ranks of office, and all persons between the ages of fifty and sixty.”

Bounty Land Rights: (generally from 200 to 500 acres) offered “to officers and men for two regiments then to be raised, for the defense of the State.”

Age Eligible To Serve: generally 16 up to 50, later raised to age 60.

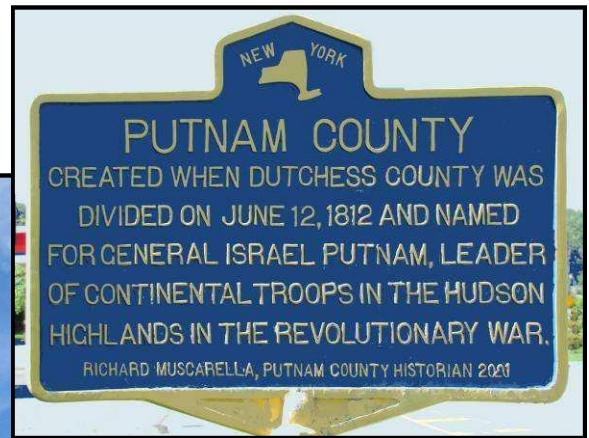

PUTNAM COUNTY

What is now Putnam County was part of Dutchess County until June 12, 1812, and the home of our Enoch Crosby Chapter, National Society Daughters of the American Revolution.

Putnam County is named after Israel Putnam, a hero of the French and Indian War and a General in the American Revolution. General Putnam was born in Salem, Massachusetts, on January 7, 1718, and died in Brooklyn, Connecticut, on May 19, 1790.



TOWN OF CARMEL

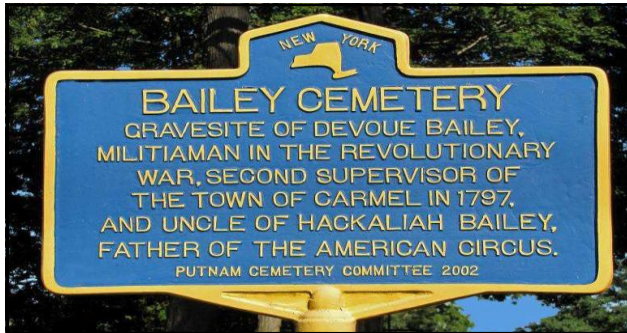
The Town of Carmel is located along the southern border of Putnam County and includes the hamlets of Carmel, Carmel Hills, Field Corners, Hopkins Corners, Mahopac, Mahopac Falls, Secor Corners, Tilly Foster, and West Mahopac. Carmel is one of the three current towns that were formed from the Town of Fredericksburg in 1795. It was named because of its supposed resemblance to Mount Carmel in the Holy Land. Carmel is the county seat of Putnam County.

TOWN OF KENT

The town of Kent is located along the northern border of Putnam County and contains the hamlets of Lake Carmel, Kent Corners, Kent Hills, and Ludingtonville. Kent is one of the three current towns that were formed from the Town of Fredericksburg in 1795 and is named after one of the early families who lived in the area.

During the Revolution, Colonel Henry Ludington and his daughter, Sybil, lived near what is now the intersection of I-84 and Ludingtonville Road. Family lore says that on April 26, 1777, Sybil, a girl who had just passed her 16th birthday, rode from her home to Cold Spring to alert the local troops to save Danbury, CT, as it was being attacked and burned by the British. Although 400 soldiers responded, they were too late to save Danbury. A statue commemorating her ride stands on the shore of Lake Gleneida in Carmel.

Entitled an Act for Raising the sum of 2,500,000 Dollars by Tax within this State.”

The list was certified 25 December 1779 and below the certification said, “To Mr. Banker Treasurer to the State of New York”. Session 3, Ch. 27. This tax was to raise \$2.5 million, of which \$2.4 million was to meet a requisition of the Continental Congress.

Last Known Act

For DAR purposes, it must be demonstrated the ancestor acted with unfailing loyalty to further the cause of American Independence, as a sailor, soldier, civil officer or for rendering acceptable patriotic service. It must also be proven the service claimed belonged to the ancestor named. Service is determined by the last known act of service to the American cause. Therefore, if a soldier was fined for failing to attend muster in 1779, services prior to the date of the fine are not accepted. If a person took an oath to the king in 1778, all services prior to the date of the oath are negated, and acceptable service must be proven as having occurred after that date.
