
A JOURNEY THROUGH NATURE

02 Little Stony Point is a beautiful and popular spot located within the Hudson Highlands State Park in Cold Spring, New York. It's a favorite destination for locals and visitors alike due to its scenic beauty and flat terrain for an easy family hike. Enjoy Riverfront Views, Short Hiking Trails & Picnicking.




01 Hudson Highlands State Park in Cold Spring, NY is known for its stunning landscapes, hiking trails, wildlife, scenic views and outdoor and seasonal activities.

O3 The Putnam Trailway, a part of the Empire State Trail, is a scenic multi-use path that runs through Putnam County offering a safe and enjoyable route for outdoor activities such as walking, running, biking and rollerblading.











04 Fred Dill Wildlife Sanctuary is a beautiful nature reserve located in Carmel, NY. It's known for its peaceful environment and natural beauty. Sanctuary is close to restaurants and shopping.

05 The Patterson Clough Preserve is a peaceful nature reserve located in Patterson, NY. Managed by the Putnam County Land Trust, this preserve offers a serene environment for outdoor activities like hiking and wildlife observation, all within a quiet woodland setting.

06 Michael Ciaiola Conservation Area is located in Patterson, NY, offers visitors a peaceful retreat with scenic trails and beautiful natural landscapes. Spanning over 800 acres, the area features wooded paths, wetlands, and a small waterfall.

- 07 Breakneck Ridge is located in the Hudson Highlands State Park, is a popular and challenging hiking destination known for its breathtaking views and steep terrain. The trail, which spans about 1.6 miles, offers hikers a strenuous ascent with rocky scrambles, leading to stunning panoramic vistas of the Hudson River and surrounding mountains.
- **08 Ninham Mountain Fire Tower**, located in Kent, NY, offers visitors a chance to experience both history and stunning views. Built in 1929, this historic fire tower once served as a lookout for forest fires. From the tower, hikers are treated to panoramic vistas of the Hudson Valley.
- O9 Fahnestock Memorial
 State Park is a large and
 diverse state park located in
 Carmel, NY. It's known for its
 natural beauty, offering a wide
 range of outdoor activities
 throughout the year, including
 swimming, hiking, camping,
 fishing, and winter sports.

GARDENS & MASTERPIECES

- **01 Boscobel House & Gardens** is a historic mansion and museum located in Garrison, NY, along the Hudson River. It is renowned for its beautifully preserved Neo-classical architecture, Federal period decorative art, stunning gardens, & panoramic views of the Hudson River.
- **O2 Stonecrop Gardens** is a stunning public garden located in Cold Spring, NY, in the heart of the Hudson Valley. Originally the private garden of Frank Cabot and his wife Anne, Stonecrop has since become a celebrated destination for garden enthusiasts, offering a diverse range of plant collections, unique garden designs, and educational programs.

03 Petra Island

Discover the Beauty of Petra Island in Mahopac, NY. The Chahroudi House is an authentic Wright building. The Massaro House is based on Frank Lloyd Wright's original drawings. O4 Magazzino Italian Art is a contemporary art museum located in Cold Spring, NY, dedicated to the study and exhibition of Postwar and Contemporary Italian art, particularly the Arte Povera movement. The museum serves as a cultural hub for Italian Art & Culture in the Hudson Valley. Stroll the ground & dine at Cafe Silvia during your visit.



o5 Hudson Valley Shakespeare is an acclaimed professional theater company located in Garrison, NY, known for its outdoor productions of Shakespearean plays & other classics. The performances take place under an open-air tent on the property of The Garrison, offering stunning views of the Hudson River and the surrounding landscape, creating a unique and immersive theater experience. A restaurant is on the premises.





SPIRITUAL RETREATS

- **O1 Chuang Yen Monastery** is a serene Buddhist monastery located in Carmel, NY, known for its peaceful setting, spiritual programs, and the largest indoor Buddha statue in the Western Hemisphere. The monastery is part of the Buddhist Association of the United States (BAUS) and serves as a center for Buddhist practice, meditation, and cultural events.
- **02 Garrison Institute:** The Garrison Institute is part of an emerging field of innovative changemaking organizations working to apply the wisdom that arises from contemplation to new action strategies for transformative social and environmental change.
- **03 Graymoor**, home to the Friars of the Atonement, is a religious community & spiritual center located in Garrison, NY. Founded in the early 20th century, Graymoor offers beautiful grounds, chapels and opportunities for spiritual retreats. Listed as one of eight pilgrimage sites for the 2025 Jubilee Year of Hope.









